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

Children's Special Health Services

Provides diagnostic and treatment services for eligible children who have certain chronic physical illnesses or serious disabilities causing (or likely to cause) impairments that could significantly limit major life activities. Services provided may include medical evaluation, parent counseling, speech therapy, occupational therapy, and genetic service. To access these services, contact your local parish health unit.

Early Steps

This program is run through DHH's Office of Public Health, helps children birth to age three and their families. Early Steps aims to help children who have conditions that might lead to a disability and also helps children who appear to have cognitive, physical, communication, social, emotional or behavioral developmental delays.

The is program is an entry point for the DD service system for children age 0-3; provides early intervention services including nutrition, therapies, assistive technology, audiology, vision, service coordination, psychological, social work, special instruction, translation/interpretation and transportation (to/from Early Steps' services only)
